



We now have new state-of-the-art technology that takes a digital image of the back of the eye.

Our doctors are now scanning with the Optomap on every annual exam. This exam will give the doctor a detailed eye health picture. We do this every year to potentially detect systemic as well as ocular diseases such as high blood pressure, diabetes, glaucoma, macular degeneration, even types of cancer. Your scan will become a permanent part of your medical record and monitored each year for any type of progression. In many cases this scan can be used in lieu of dilation.

The universal co-pay for this type of exam is typically \$39, but we only charge \$28, to be collected at time of service. This co-pay is not covered by insurance.
